An ongoing mural project curated and managed by Well and Good, Brighten The Corners is designed to enrich lives, inspire its inhabitants and revitalize communities through the creation of large scale art and murals in our streets and shared spaces.

Church and Shuter Streets, Toronto 2009  
Artists: Elicser, Mediah, Silhouette + Chor Boogie

This mural is an exploration of faith for the Metropolitan United Church in downtown Toronto. Four artists created the Paint Your Faith mural. It stands over 2 stories high and 60 feet from end to end. Witnessing the impact this 3-week production had upon the neighbourhood was a formative experience; solidifying for us the important role art plays in the health of communities.



Dundas and Spadina Streets, Toronto 2010  
Artists: Horus, EGR + Roadsworth

This 185-foot long alley revitalization project borders one of the city's busiest intersections. Commissioned as part of Mayor Miller's '20 Minute Makeover' and produced with the support and partnership of Chinatown BIA, The City of Toronto, Beautiful Streets Secretariat, Councillor Adam Vaughan, Toronto Police Services and Subway Academy 2.



The Esplanade & Berkeley Street, Toronto 2010

This new mural lives in a public square opposite St. Lawrence Community Center. It is a work in progress to be completed in the Spring and Summer of 2011.



Fairbank Pool, Dufferin & Key West, 2011

The 112 foot mural is entitled 'Evolution of Aquarius' and was created in aerosol for the 2011 City of Toronto 20 Minute Makeover: A joint project led by the city with participation from 13 Division Toronto Police Services and the Community Mobilization Unit with Councillor Colle of Ward 15.
